The Tribal Welfare Department has sent the proposal for upgrading the following (5) existing TW Residential Schools into Colleges of Excellence.

The S.T. Residential Schools now sanctioned will start with entry point from VIII class and year-after-year, the classes will be upgraded from VIII class to VIIth class and upto XIth class. The students opting for MPC & BPC will be admitted in the XIth and XIIth class. The number of posts under different categories in Residential Junior Colleges will come into force with effect from commencement of XIth and XIIth Classes of the above proposed schools.

TRIBAL WELFARE - Education - Sanction of Residential Schools under Art-275(1) of the Constitution of India with 100% contribution by Government of India under Centrally Sponsored Scheme during 1998-99 - Sanction Orders - Issued.

ORDER:-

In the reference first read above, Government of India sanctioned an amount of Rs.1.00 Crore (Rupees One Crore only) for the specific purpose of setting up of 6 (Six) S.T. Residential Schools for Classes 6th to 12th for S.T. students for the year 1997-98. The objective of setting up of these Residential Schools is to provide quality education to the S.T. students. Government of India allotted (6) Residential Schools to the State of Andhra Pradesh for the year 1997-98. The amount of Rs.1.00 Crore which was already released by Government of India is for the purpose of setting up of (6) S.T. Residential Schools during 1997-98. Orders have already been issued in G.O. third read above, sanctioning One S.T. Residential Junior College in Adilabad District at Narnoor and two S.T. Residential Schools at Warangal District at Dornakal - Kuravi and Mahabubnagar District at Balanagar respectively out of Six (6) referred to above.

2. The Commissioner of Tribal Welfare in the reference second read above has proposed to open the remaining (3) S.T. Residential Schools out of 6 (Six) referred to above during 1998-99 in view of the persistent demand and due to prevalence of low literacy rate among boys and girls in and around the Villages and Mandals of the District as detailed below:-

3. To start the above (3) S.T. Residential Schools under Centrally Sponsored Scheme, the following staff are required for each school from VIII class to XIIth class with two sections consisting of 45 students in each section.

6. Besides extending the contract services on contract basis as in the case of Andhra Pradesh (Social Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society), the following services may be engaged on contract basis.

- (a) Electrical and Plumbing services.
- (b) Sanitation services.
- (c) Watch and ward can also be tried though our schools located in very interior areas and such private agencies providing watch and ward services may not be available.

7. The Commissioner of Tribal Welfare has requested Government to release the amount of Rs.1.00 Crore (Rupees One Crore only) to the Secretary, Andhra Pradesh Tribal Welfare Ashram and Residential Educational Institutions Society towards establishment of (3) Residential Schools also out of 6 (six) sanctioned by Government of India under Centrally Sponsored Scheme.

8. The Commissioner of Tribal Welfare is accordingly authorised to incur an expenditure not exceeding Rs.30.00 lakhs (Rupees Thirty Lakhs only) towards maintenance of Three Residential Schools from the available funds pending release of funds by the central government.

9. The expenditure sanctioned shall be debited to the following Head of Account :
"2225 - Welfare of S.Cs., S.Ts, and O.B.Cs. - 02 - Welfare of S.Ts. - H.H. 277 Education schemes included in the Plan - S.H. (12) Residential School for Tribals - 090 - Grant-in-aid - 092 - other Grants-in-aid(Plan)"
