ORDER:

The Social Welfare (TW.Ser.III) Department have stated that in the reference 1st read above, the Secretary, Andhra Pradesh Tribal Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society (Gurukulam) has stated that for smooth functioning of Tribal Welfare Residential Schools and Colleges for the benefit and enhancing the Educational standards to the Tribal Students in the State and is dire need to sanction additional teaching staff. The Secretary Andhra Pradesh Tribal Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society (Gurukulam) has requested the Government to sanction 576 additional teaching staff posts in various categories along with budgetary requirement of Rs.20.68 crores. After examining the proposal it was decided to create 576 new teaching posts in Gurukulam, 50% of the requirement shall be proposed for this (2011-2012) for sanction and the balance posts shall be proposed for the next year (2012-2013) for sanction. Accordingly in the reference 3rd read above Andhra Pradesh Tribal Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society (Gurukulam) has submitted proposal for sanction of 50% of the (576) additional posts i.e. (288) posts during 2011-12 & (288) posts during 2012-13.

2. In the circumstances stated by the Secretary Andhra Pradesh Tribal Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society (Gurukulam) in the reference 3rd read above, Govt., after careful examination of the matter hereby accord sanction for creation of 50% of the (576) following additional posts i.e., 288 (Two Hundred and Eighty Eight Only) in various categories in Gurukulam Institutions during the year 2011-2012 as detailed below.
