All the Principals are aware about the establishment of new Society to manage Tribal Residential Educational Institutions in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited and its functioning from 1.6.99 . 52 Tribal Residential Institutions previously managed by the APREIS have been transferred to APTWREIS on 1.6.99.

In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited revised options were called from the staff working in both the societies either to continue in APREIS or to go to APTWREIS.They were informed that if the no.of employees in a particular cadre opted to remain in APREIS is more than the posts sanctioned, the services of the Juniors in that particular cadre will be kept under the disposal of APTWREIS, though they opted to remain in APREI Society. It was also informed that no conditional options will be entertained.

In the meeting held on 10.04.2001 with the office bearers of the Staff Associations in the chambers of the Vice-Chairman, it was resolved to take the services of all the staff members opted to APREI Society in all cadres to the extent of vacancies available . Subsequently it was decided to keep the bifurcation in the category of Superintendent pending since the finalisation of the seniority is under dispute. It was further resolved to surrender the services of the staff to APTWREI Society permanently who opted for APTWREIS. It was also resolved to send the juniors to APTWREIS

permanently though they have opted for APREIS due to non availability of the vacancies in APREIS.

In view of bifurcation and General transfers it is decided to adopt the transfer policy as formulated in the Education Department.

In the reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited, Government issued orders to effect transfers of staff in Government/Zilla Parishad High Schools through counselling.

- 1) In view of the above G.O. the APREI Society has decided to bifurcate the services of the staff between APREIS & APTWREIS and to effect transfers through counselling as per the G.O.Ms.No.118 with little modification of certain clauses to suit the needs of APREIS (particulars of modifications enclosed in Annexure-I).
- 2) The particulars of staff who come under para(5) of the modifications(Annexure-I) should be submitted with due verification of Service Registers etc to the secretary through special messenger who is deputed to submit the transfer applications ~~at Head office on 30.4.2001.~~
- 3) APREI Society has processed the options exercised by the staff (as on 08.11.2000) and a list of allotment of staff to either of the Society is enclosed.
- 4) The staff who allotted to APTWREIS may attend for counselling at APTWREIS for further posting in APTWREIS as per the schedule to be given by APTWREIS.
- 5) The representations made for any transfer previously will not be considered now. They have to apply for transfer in the prescribed proforma through the Principal concerned and they have to attend for counselling.
- 6) The staff who have allotted to APREIS have to attend for counselling. They should apply for transfer duly filling the application form prescribed for this purpose (Annexure-II). Filled in application form should be submitted to the concerned Principal on or before 25.04.2001.
- 7) *Gen boys school of* The Principals are hereby requested to submit the transfer applications to the ~~Secretary, APREIS~~ *22/4/01* on or before ~~28~~ 04.2001 by special messenger along with the particulars of staff completed 10 years of service in the same place( irrespective of institution and cadre). If Principals failed to submit the transfer applications of staff within the stipulated time they will be held responsible and action will be initiated against them.
- 8) No TA/DA will be paid for the staff who are attending for counselling.
- 9) No TTA will be paid for the staff who are transferred through counselling.

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- 10) In case any employee who completed 10 years of service at one place or the male teacher working the Girls Institution fail to attend for counselling, the secretary shall have the right to post him/her against vacancy wherever exist.
- 11) The Principals of APRE Institutions are hereby requested to communicate these orders to the staff members and obtain proper acknowledgement from them. A copy of acknowledgement may be submitted to this office along with transfer application forms.
- 12) If the Spouse is allotted to APTWREIS his/her counter part who is allotted to APREIS is permitted to go to APTWREIS.
- 13) This process should be treated as most urgent.
- 14) The Principals of APREIS are hereby requested to communicate the individual orders sent by this office to the staff allotted to APTWREIS and take proper acknowledgement from the staff.
- 15) Principals concerned are requested to make necessary entries in Service Registers of individuals.
- 16) Regarding the date of relief of staff who are allotted to APTWREIS, the Principals are informed to wait for further orders of Secretary, APREI Society.  
Receipt of these proceedings should be acknowledged.

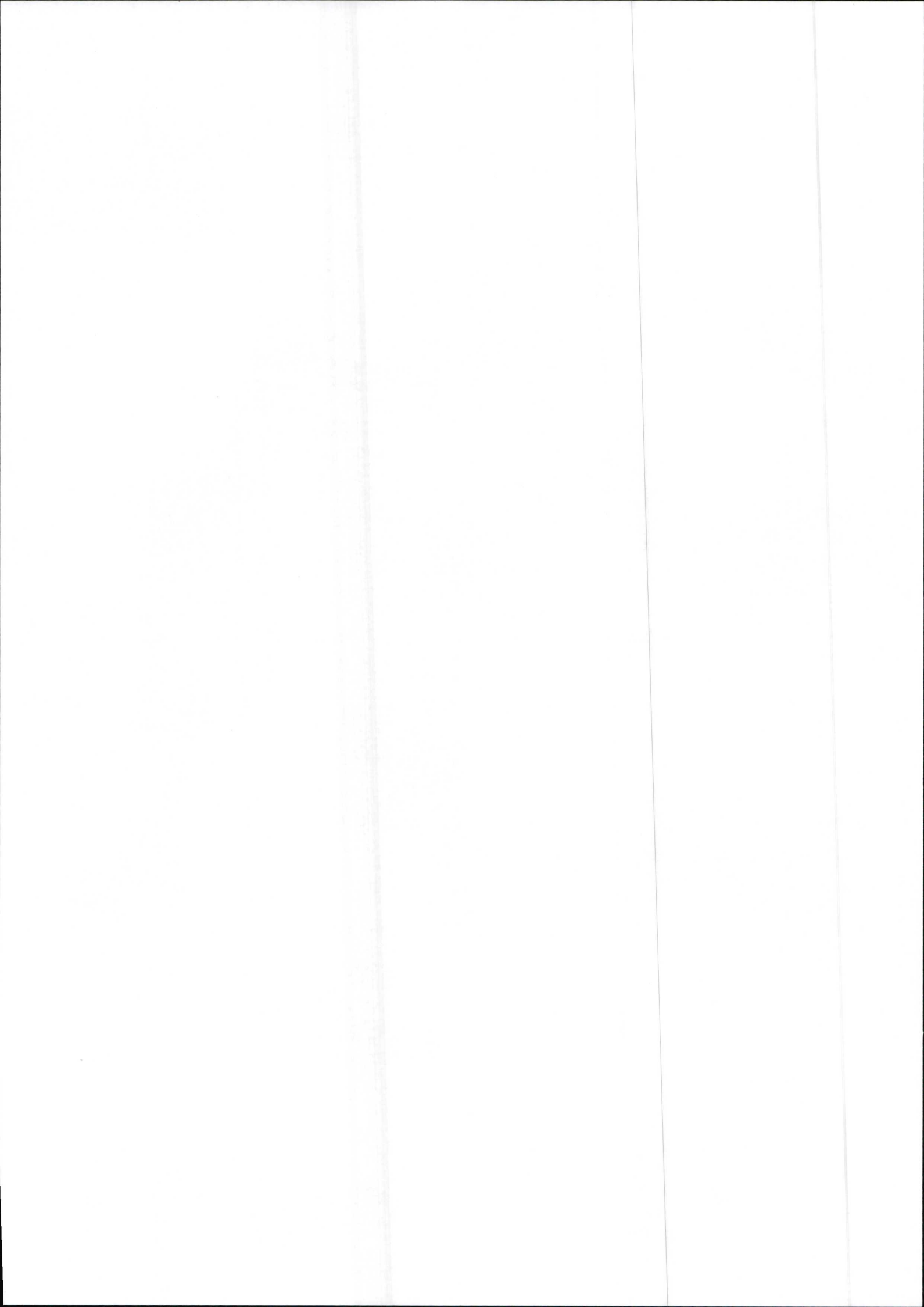

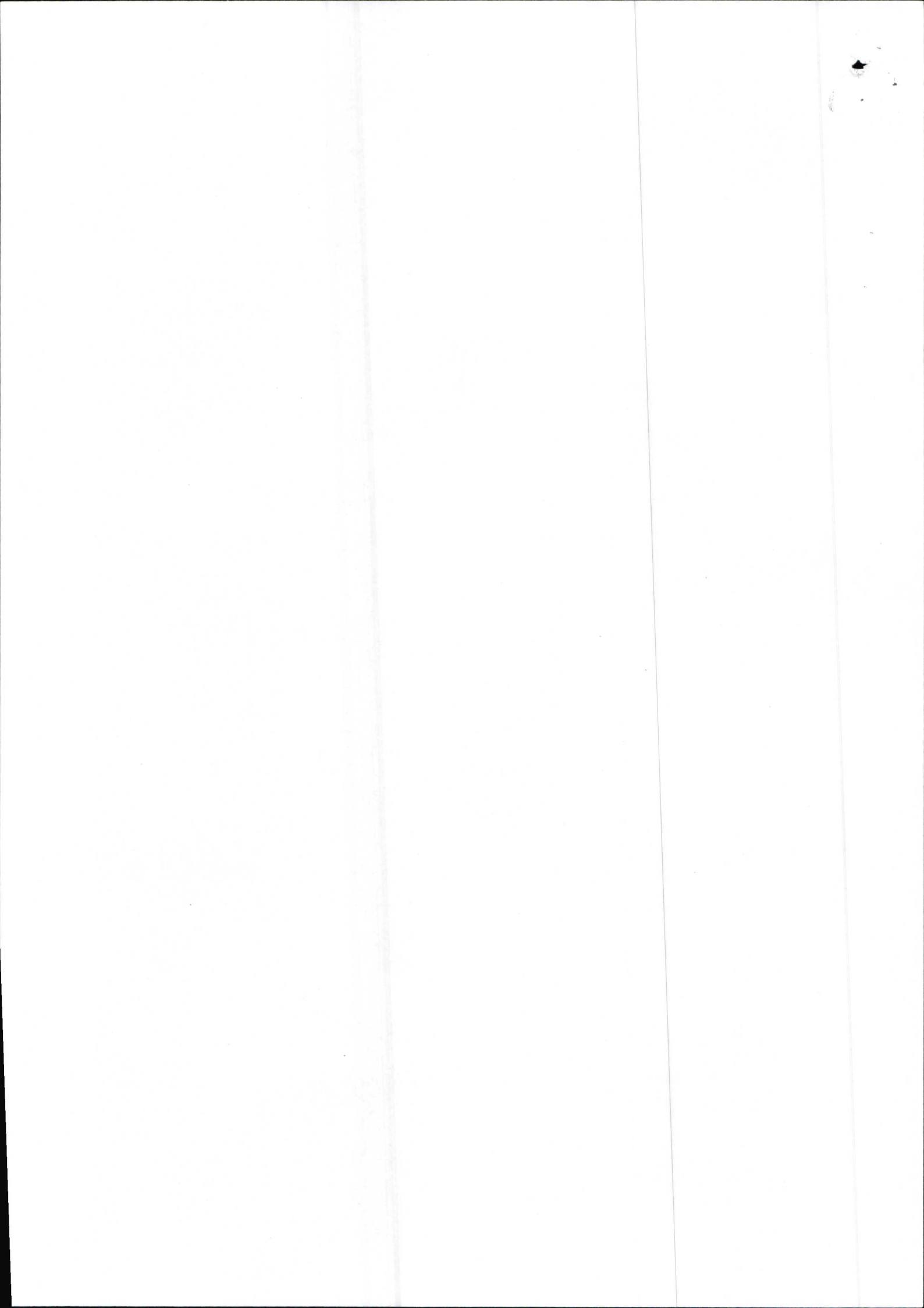

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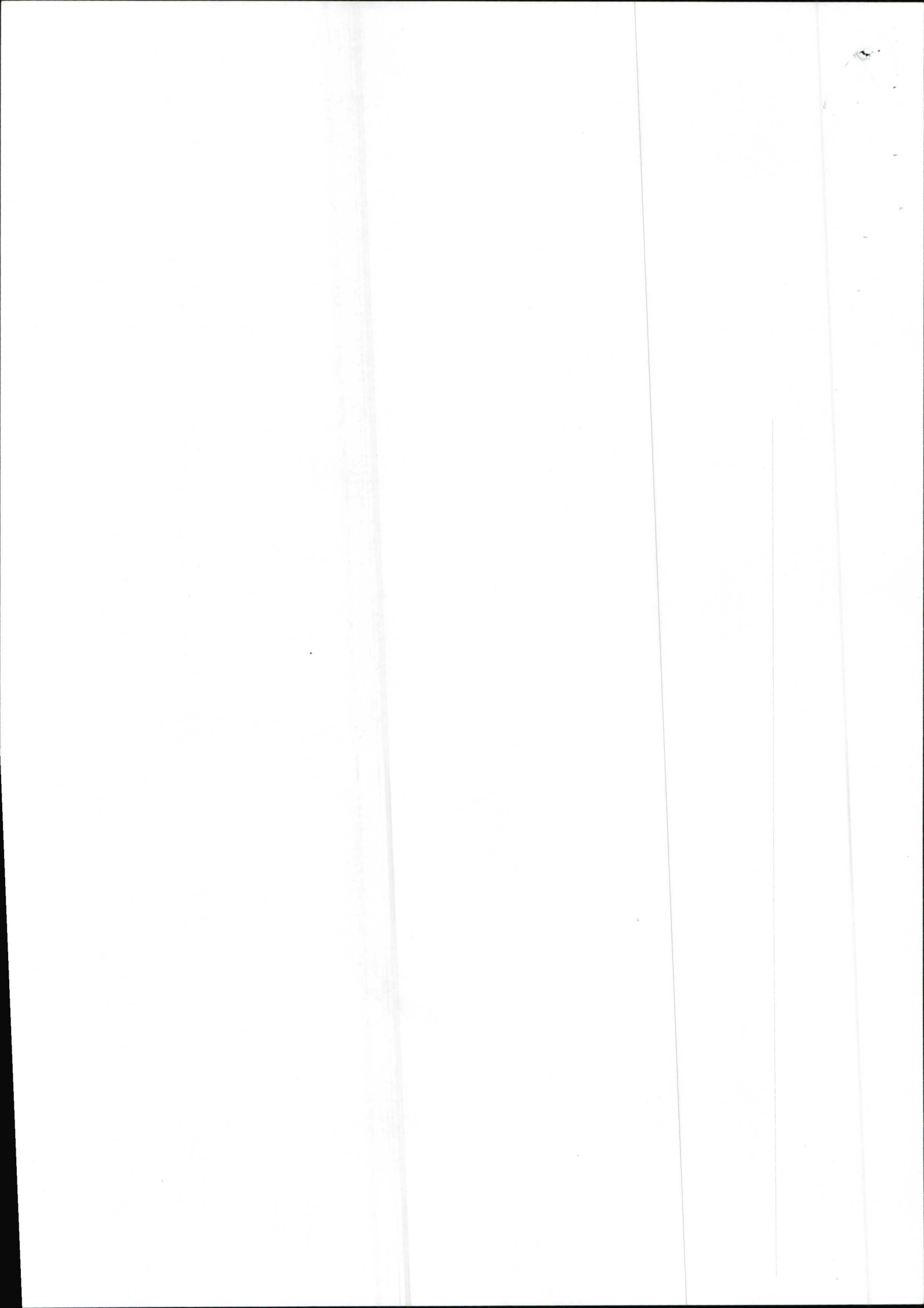

**SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT** – Creation of a Society to establish and manage Ashram and Residential Educational Institutions for the benefit of Scheduled Tribes in the state with the name of Andhra Pradesh Tribal Welfare Ashram and Residential Education Institutions Society (APTWAREIS) – Orders – Issued.

1. Rc.No.D2/8036/97, from Commissioner of Tribal Welfare, dt.23-07-1997.

**ORDER:**

Government have reviewed the status of literacy among the Scheduled Tribes (ST) in the State. The review revealed that the literacy rate among the Scheduled Tribes in the State is only 17% as per 1991 census which is one of the lowest in the country. This is also very poor in comparison to the general literacy rate of about 45% (1991 census) for the State as a whole. It has also come to the notice of the Government that female literacy rate among STs is less than 5% in more than seven districts of the State. It is further noticed between 1990-1996. While the rate of growth of literacy for the general population is of the order of 13%, only 9% for the Scheduled Tribes.

2. Government recognise, the importance of literacy and education for the tribals to enable them to join main stream of national life. As the tribals live in small hamlets which are located in very remote and inaccessible areas with varied dialects and way of life, there is need for an intensive and appropriate strategy for achieving quick results. Keeping the above dismal state of literacy among the Scheduled Tribes and the problems associated with the areas inhabited by them. In view, Government is of the opinion that there is an urgent need to devise an appropriate strategy for the benefit of the STs with special emphasis on the education of ST girl children.

3. Accordingly, it is decided to establish an exclusive Society with the required autonomy and functional flexibility, to take care of enrolment and retention of tribal children and improvement in the quality of education imparted to them with head quarters at Hyderabad. All the residential/ ashram institutions being managed by Tribal Welfare Education (including APREIS) and Labour and Employment Departments for the benefit of tribals shall stand transferred to the management and control of the above Society alongwith the budget allocated made in the capital and Revenue Heads. The Society shall be responsible for the efficient management and running of the educational institutions entrusted to it from time to time.

4. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance and Planning (Finance.EBS) Department vide U.O. Note No. 44475/A/255/A1/EBS.XIV/97, dt.27-11-1997.
